Job Description

- To attend meetings of the EPA Coaching Commission and to inform the SXP coaches and SXP MC of decisions, policies and developments made by the EPA Coaching Commission
- To provide support to Club and Advanced Club Coaches within SXP ensuring adequate coaching is provided to new and established clubs and players; and through coaching :-
 - increase the level of performance of players
 - pass on experience
 - bring out the best in others
 - further the progress and development of the sport
- In the absence of Club Coaches provide adequate coaching to new and established SXP clubs and players
- Where qualified to do so assist and/or organise Club Coach training courses
- To identify and encourage potential coaches and assist and advise them towards becoming a coach
- To be responsible for the encouragement and development of the SXP Espoirs
- To provide support to the SXP Youth Development Officer where appropriate
- To attend SXP MC meetings
- To provide a report at the SXP AGM
- To undertake other duties that may be needed for the benefit of SXP
- To promote a positive image of SXP and be an ambassador for the region
- To be aware of and work within the EPA's Coaching Code of Conduct, Junior and Vulnerable Members Protection Policy, Member's Code of Conduct and Equity Policy
- Not to bring the name or reputation of SXP in disrepute

Qualifications

- To hold or be working towards a recognised EPA Coaching qualification (Club Coach as minimum) and to seek to develop coaching competences through ongoing training
- To work towards obtaining County Coach qualification and where possible towards National Coach qualification
- To possess a current and valid DBS certificate in accordance with the EPA
